FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Held under the general regulations of the MSUK Ltd (incorporating the provision of the international sporting code of the FISA) and the supplementary regulations.

Dear Competitor

The organisers would like to draw your attention to the following final instructions, all of which, together with the details of tests, bear the same force as the supplementary regulations for the event.

1. Trailer parking is located at 'The Barn', Ansteads Farm and will be arrowed from the Catswood Lane, Please park as directed by the marshal. NO STOPPING ON THE DRIVE OR DRIVING ON THE GRASS.
2. The first car starts at 9.30am. Competitors will leave the scrutineering area and be escorted in groups to appropriate sections according to the running order.
3. Please join the queue as arrowed for scrutineering as soon as possible. Once scrutineered park where directed. Sign on will only take place after you have completed scrutineering which will be in an obvious location.
4. There will not be a mobile catering service for food or drinks. Please note that toilet facilities will be provided at Scrutineering and near section 1 in the woods.
5. All cars to display a colour disc attached to the front of the car or on the windscreen, this shall identify the class the vehicle is competing. Class 1 & 2 – BLUE, Class 3, 4 & 5 – WHITE Class 6 & 7 – YELLOW and Class 8 – RED.
6. Fire extinguishers will be checked.
7. As per 2013 MSUK Regulations all cars must carry a spill kit.
8. Only the entrance that signs on as the driver to drive the car at all times.
9. In all cases give way to walkers and horse riders. If confronted by a hostile member of the public, listen and talk courteously and if possible send for an organising official or marshal.
10. Please acquaint yourself with the regulations for this event, particularly those relating to unattended vehicles, seating of the driver/passenger, no advertising and appearance or condition of vehicle.
11. Cars must have either a rope or large ring, which is capable of having a towrope quickly and firmly attached to both the front and rear of the car. No rope or ring NO START.
12. The event is routed along or across public right of way. Competitors must exercise caution and reduce their speed accordingly when other path users are near. Be especially careful near horses, stop and switch off your engine.

13. Tyre pressures will be set at Scrutineering and MUST NOT be altered by any competitor.

HANDICAP for All Train Tyres or Tyres that fit the 8mm rule.

14. Wheel/tyre regulations will be as per entry form.
15. Results will be provisionally announced at the end of the event and will be published soon after.
16. Most sections may be walked/inspected prior to your first attempt only, this does not include section number 7 where a diagram will be shown at the start line. Competing crew must not pass section begins on foot. Any section **SIGNIFICANTLY** changed between rounds after the 1st round may be inspected again subject to instruction by the marshals.
17. Markers posts will help define sections, markers or back markers deemed to have been hit on purpose to gain advantage will be recorded as the point of failure, an accidental touch of marker posts will not be deemed as the point of failure, as determined by the marshals who are judges of fact, no abuse towards any marshal will be tolerated – penalty – exclusion.
18. A lunch break will be taken in the woods at the queue for section begins for the first section of your third round. We will rest for 30 minutes.
19. Competitors are reminded to remain in numerical order throughout the event, please regain your position in the event of an issue to allow sections to be altered as necessary, there will be no reversing of order after lunch.
20. Steward of the event is Miss Kelly Thomas.
21. Scrutineer of the event is Mr Mark Hobbs.
22. Clerk of the Course for the event is Mr Peter Hayward
23. Secretary of the event is Mrs Gill Hayward
24. Chief Marshal for the event is Miss Sandie Tozer
25. If you are a retirement and are leaving the woods/venue please notify a member of the organising team (so we don't keep looking for you)
26. Competitors are reminded that the woods are slippery and caution must be exercised with moving through the woodland.
27. NO Pets in any competing car.
28. Passenger MUST be seated.
29. Give way to ALL foot traffic.
30. Maximum speed between sections 15 mph.
31. Results will NOT be calculated by index of performance.
