Stroud and District Motor Club will organise Clubmans Car Trial on Sunday 5th July 2026.

From there you will be signposted into the gateway and across the field. Signing-on, scrutineering and trailer parking will be signed in the field.

1. All drivers AND passengers must produce a valid club membership card and the minimum of a Motorsport UK Ltd RS Clubman Licence (free). Applicants for RS Clubman license who have answered yes to medical questions WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO DRIVE on the day but will be allowed to passenger on the day. For applicants who answer yes to these, when Motorsport UK Ltd. receives the application form, the medical team will assess the information and decide on suitability to drive (The applicant will be contacted by Motorsport UK Ltd.). For passengers under the age of 18, a letter of parental consent is required.

Passengers may join Stroud & District Motor Club as a passenger

2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motorsport UK Limited (incorporating provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for this event.
 3. Motorsport UK Permit Number: to be confirmed in Final Instructions.
 4. The event is open at all members of Stroud & District Motor Club, as well as those of invited clubs. This event is a round of the Cotswold Motor Sport Group of which competitors of the championship are invited.
 5. Children in cars under the age of 18 must have signed consent from either a parent or guardian and comply with MSUK guidelines on children being properly seated in the car T4.1.5 to T4.1.7
 6. Scrutineering starts at 09.00am. First car starts at 10.00am. Any competitor not signed on by 09.45am may be excluded.
 7. Public roads will not be used to link sections. There will be at least 5 tests of private land. Details of tests will be issued at signing on. The entry may be split into groups starting at different hills.
 8. The event will consist of 6 classes as follows:
 - 8.1. **Class 1:** Front engine, front wheel drive production cars without ballast **Under 1400cc and including 1400cc.**
A sump guard weighing no more than 10kg (including fittings) may be fitted.
 - 8.2. **Class 2:** Front engine, front wheel drive, with ballast **or any front wheel drive car over 1400cc.**
 - 8.3. **Class 3:** Front engine, rear wheel drive production saloons and production sports cars
 - 8.4. **Class 4:** Rear engine, rear wheel drive production cars
 - 8.5. **Class 5:** Kit cars
 - 8.6. **Class 6:** Specials
- Index of performance will apply to all classes to determine overall results.
- Classification of any vehicle in the event will entirely be at the discretion of the organisers.
9. **All vehicles must carry a Motorsport UK approved fire extinguisher.** The minimum quantity being 2.4 litres of AFFF or 2Kg of Dry Power. Ref T11.7.3 and must be present in the vehicle. Tyre pressures will be

imposed for the event; minimum tyre pressures will be advised at scrutineering.

Tyre pressures may be varied at the organisers' discretion if conditions dictate, Ref T1.3.22

10. **Awards will be presented at the Annual Awards Dinner and Dance on Saturday 21st NOVEMBER.**

The awards are as follows:

First Overall,	by index:	Vice Presidents Cup
First in Class:		An award
Second in Class,	subject to 6 entries:	An award
Third in Class,	subject to 10 entries:	An award
Best Novice,	by index,	subject to 3 starters: An award
First Lady,	by index,	Gill Hayward Trophy
Best Junior,	by index,	subject to 3 starters: An award

11. **The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and closes on Tuesday 30th June.**

The entry fee will be £37.00 (£17.00 for junior members). Entries are to be made using MyClubHouse

16. Competitors will be identified by numbers, which will be supplied at signing on by the organisers. They must be displayed in a prominent forward-facing position on the car.
17. Marking and penalties will be as printed in the appropriate section of the Motorsport UK General Regulations T6.1 to T6.4.5
18. All other General Regulations of the Motorsport UK apply as written, except that:
 - 18.1. As the event takes place wholly on private land, cars need not be taxed or insured for the public road.
 - 18.2. No practising will be allowed.
19. All Marshals are deemed to be judges of fact regarding marks lost on sections. Any disputes are to be raised with the Clerk of Course, NOT the marshal. Abuse towards marshals will not be tolerated and may result in exclusion and / or disciplinary action. The marshals signing-on sheet will be displayed at the signing on area before the start of the competition.
20. **A/T, M+S and Winter type tyres are not permitted at our Car Trials (PCTs).**
As the venues used for our events become increasingly sensitive, we need to ensure every effort is made to minimise damage to the land.
